Chef Gonzo has made a (very cool) name for himself dishing out Mediterranean-meets-Mexican fare at Esperanza's bluffside eatery, three stone terraces that cascade down to the sand. Dinner for two, \$130.

Tourists, natives, and Oprah all heart Polynesian-themed Mama's Fish House, in Paia, where the homemade desserts (mmm—chocolate pie with caramel-cookie crust) are sheer sugar heaven. Dinner for two, \$200.

Engage in a little horseplay at the Half Moon Equestrian Centre in Montego Bay. Your trusty steed will tow you through shallow seas—just hang on for the ride!; \$160 for two.

Whales migrate to Cabo (even they know it's fab) and stay from December through March. encounter with some spouting species; \$140 for two.

MONTAUK / New York

Gwyneth Paltrow, Vanessa Minnillo, and True Blood cutie Ryan Kwanten swing by this laid-back town on Long Island's eastern end. We swooned over the Surf Lodge, the area's hottest nightspot and hotel, which has cheery rooms

LONG BRANCH / New Jersey

Snooki and the Situation aside, the Shore isn't all guid-ettes and gorillas. Boldfacers like Ashley Tisdale consider it hip thanks to Bungalow, a boutique hotel from 9 by Design's Cortney and Bob Novogratz. Bunk up there like the Tis and you're
