NO, NOT THAT **SCARBOROUGH**

Sometimes a fly-and-flop is just the ticket and it doesn't get much better than Tobago.

DialAFlight has a seven-night break at Le Grand Courlan Spa Resort in Stonehaven. The four-star resort, with private beach, is just five miles from the island's lively capital city, Scarborough. Life revolves around sunbathing. Soak up the rays on the hotel's two tennis courts or try out treatments in the spa. Just don't mess about too much on your own on the island after dark.

Little-visited volcanic island St Vincent deserves more visitors. The cash-savvy place to stay is 18th-century Grenadine House in the suburbs of capital Kingstown. The reason it is possible to bag a bargain here is because it is not on the beach. Lonely Planet destination editor Lorna Parkes says: "Sea views can really hike up
