JAMAICA Seaweed Luxury Villa

The boho beach crowd play reggae beats and drink cans of Red Stripe until long after the sun goes down on Calabash Bay in Treasure Beach. Jakes hotel, with its chilled atmosphere and cool digs, is where many of the barefoot, sun-bleached-blondes stay; and the hotel has its own collection of villas.

The most spectacular new addition to the collection is Seaweed Luxury Villa. It's made up of two adjoining properties, a two-bedroomed house and a four-bedroomed house - or both can be rented together to sleep up to 12 people. Turquoise-hued interiors are beach-chic at its best, with swirly patterns, shells and quirky pieces by Island Art Jamaica. The sound system extends outdoors, where there's a waterfall-like infinity pool that you could happily laze in the all day long, and a barbecue, firepit and bar for late-night soirées.

Castaway to nearby Floyd's Pelican Bar, a driftwood shack haphazardly plonked in the sea, for grilled fish and more rum.
