Double rooms with garden views from £72, room only (best for families, as they can be connected), up to £265 suites **so close** to the sea, you could dangle your toes in it (001876 965 3000, Jakeshotel.com).

On hippie Treasure Beach

on the island's undeveloped south coast.

Lounging around the central pool you'll find honeymooners, older hippies, and Jamaican veterans after a more 'local' experience.

Think 'beach-reclaimed-luxe' — shells, sand-beaten bits of glass and floaty fabrics lend a laid-back, artsy vibe to the decor. But in the surf-side Octopus cottages, rooftop sunloungers provide a spot of glam.

Chilled-out Jack Sprat Shack does passable pizzas — and **phenomenal jerk crab**. The main restaurant has a changing menu of locally sourced delights (expect fish).

A zippy speedboat ride over to the Pelican Bar, on stilts out in the ocean. It's £60 for a transfer, but

drinking rum waist-high in the blue can't be beat.

The blissfully remote location also means you're darnfar from just about everything else on the island. Also, Treasure Beach is a misnomer — for sand, you have to walk down the coast.

Wi-fi is dodgy or non-existent in most rooms, so prepare to switch off — or hang out in the lobby or restaurant to get online.
